The political action committee Portland For All recently made and disseminated a professionally-produced video for the purpose of promoting Carmen Rubio's candidacy for Portland Mayor (you can find it here --> https://www.instagram.com/reel/C_137_JPjFE/?igsh=M3hrZDRrdHZndDFh). The video lacks any Paid For By disclosure, yet clearly utilizes a professional videographer as well as graphic design work that implies that it would have cost money to create, or at least consisted of an unreported in-kind contribution. They tag Roseto Films, a professional film production company, and credit them for the production. This has the look of a political ad that lacks disclosure, and an unreported campaign finance contribution.
