QUESTION

Shall City Charter be amended to strengthen and maintain police patrol capacity, add drug treatment centers, and enhance nonviolent response?

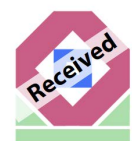
SUMMARY

The measure adds a Charter section for City Council to:

- Increase and maintain the number of police officers on patrol;
- Increase and maintain drug/alcohol detoxication drop-off and treatment centers in partnership with other governmental entities;
- Increase and maintain street response services, including using trained social workers to work cooperatively with police and fire medical personnel to reduce violent interactions and connect people in need with social services; and
- Fund the integrated approach to public safety and social services using available cannabis/marijuana tax and licensing revenue, general funds, and other funds, consistent with City Charter.
