 - c. Recommend a roll-out plan for administering the pilot training program coordinating with other agencies, including but not limited to OLCC, OHA and Multnomah County Health Department
3. Deliver meeting and activity updates within quarterly reports, including conducting research to develop and propose recommendations to CPOT for the annual report.
