Andersen Construction - Fremont Apt Early Morning Concrete Work

Request for a total of 48 early morning start-time (5 am) workdays between 04/2021 and 06/2022 to accommodate concrete pours on a new 17-story apartment building at 1550 NW Naito Parkway. Work to include the use of concrete trucks, concrete pump trucks, and mobile hydraulic cranes. Concrete pours will occur on 33 of the 48 days. Assembly and disassembly of man/material hoist, tower crane and mobile cranes will occur on the remaining 15 requested days.

Tri-Met MAX Blue Line Rail Improvement Project

Request for a total of 9 non-consecutive work-nights and two Sundays between May 15-23, 2021 to make rail improvements in the vicinity of NE 33rd Ave overpass and at Gateway Transit Center. Equipment to be used at various sites include air compressors, tractor-trailer rigs, high rail trucks, generators, light plants, welding machines, rail saws and grinders and excavators.
