WHAT

What are Minor Labels?

- Minor Labels are permits for qualified minor types of trade work: Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical.
- Contractors purchase a book of 10; placing Minor Labels on jobs as the work is performed.
- Once all 10 Minor Labels are used, the book is returned to the jurisdiction with authority – in this case, the City of Portland.

WHERE

Where are Minor Labels typically posted?

- Minor Labels are typically posted on the Electrical panel, per State and City Minor Label program guidelines.
- Visit www.PortlandMaps.com to research Minor Labels for a property. Search by property address to view Permit information (*listed under the “Permits + Zoning” tab*).
- A “Returned” status indicates a Minor Label in need of inspection.

WHY

Why should I ensure a Minor Label is inspected?

- Minor Label inspection ensures the installation is safe and approved by a City Inspector.
