#### Streamlining Solar Project Overview

There is a city-wide effort to prioritize work that makes a positive impact on climate change.

The Bureau of Development Services is focusing on improving the solar permit process in collaboration with our solar permit customers.

**Numerous process updates** have been put in place over the last year.

Today's presentation focuses on updates and improvements to the application submission process.









#### Streamlining Solar Project Overview

The changes shared today are in response to feedback we received from our customers who have requested a simplified, more automated application process.

We will continue to partner with our solar customers with a focus on continuous improvement.







## Technology Project Approach

#### **Cross-functional collaboration**

- Project definition was a collective effort
- Worked across bureau teams throughout

#### **Customer experience focus**

- Outlined customer stakeholder process, pains, gains, and goals
- Data-driven approach through analysis of rejection categories
- Updates to website support content

#### **Continuous improvement**

- Initial project requirements used to develop a phased approach
- Captured additional requirements for future improvements

























- Modern application interface and navigation
- Mobile-responsive format
- Built-in application completion process support
- Links to website information relevant to the application available throughout and placed with areas typically needing support











**APPROACH** 

- Checklist questions in a wizard-style format that only asks for information based on the specifics of the project
- Answers to questions will inform the applicant whether their project qualifies for prescriptive, in real time
- Application support built into the Q&A format









- Reduces the need to upload documents
  - Only requires documentation that is relevant to the specific project
  - An application summary is emailed to the applicant after submission
- Eliminated uploaded required documents that were often incomplete and resulted in application rejection
- Ability to submit an application when an address isn't available

### Ongoing Improvement Efforts

#### **Streamlining Solar Project**

- Establishing customer working groups and committees to continue process improvement
- Steering Committee established and held first meeting in July
- Engineering Focus Group established and held first meeting this October

#### **Customer Survey**

- Survey going out to applicants weekly to get feedback on improvements
- Will share feedback and any updates that result from feedback
