**Water**


All animals need clean water

different types of shelter.




**Shelter**

made from grasses and mud.




All animals need space.

hawk.




Oxygen

All animals need  
oxygen to survive!



Fish use gills to get oxygen  
from the water. A beaver uses  
its lungs to breathe oxygen  
from the air.

**Riparian** means the land next to water.
