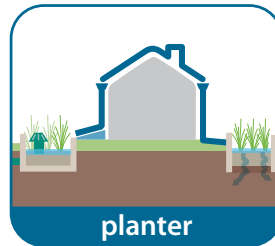

Question 1. Rain from roof(s)

All of the rain from paved areas flows to the sewer or into a street, public sidewalk, or waterbody.

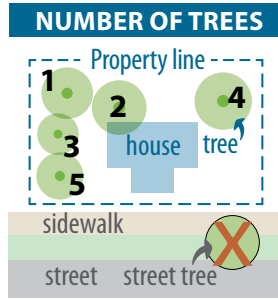
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Question 3. Trees – Number or Canopy

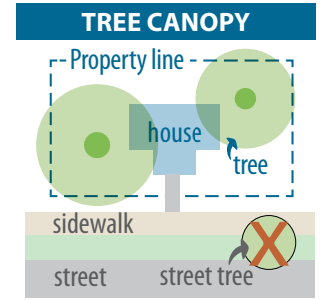

Clean River Rewards Rules & Regulations

The city grants Clean River Rewards discounts in accordance with program rules and regulations outlined in the Clean River Rewards Administrative Rules (ENB 4.16) at portland.gov/bes/enb4-16. These include, but are not limited to:

1. The discount is limited to up to 35% of the stormwater charges.
2. Ratepayers must register to receive a Clean River Rewards discount.
3. An active utility account is required to register.
4. Private stormwater management facilities must be properly located, sized, and maintained.
5. Ratepayer must comply with storm system discharge requirements and industrial discharge permits if applicable in order to receive a Clean River Rewards discount.
6. With permission of the property owner, Environmental Services staff will be allowed access to the property to conduct site inspections of stormwater facilities when registering for the discount.
7. The city may reverse granted discounts and credits, impose an administrative fee, and revoke future discounts in response to the filing of a fraudulent registration or the violation of program rules.
