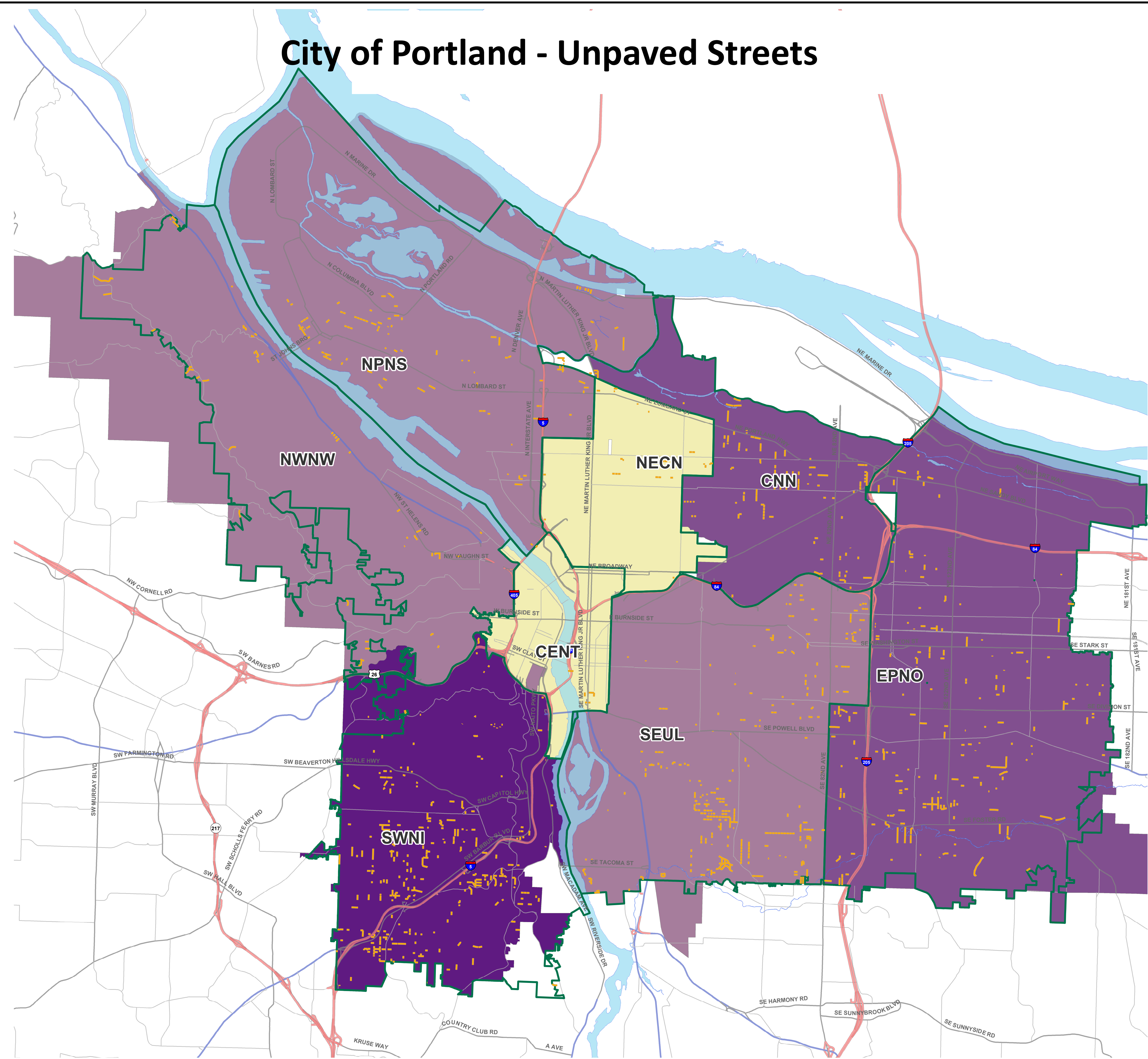

There are approximately 2,062 centerline miles of streets in the City of Portland. Sixty and a half centerline miles of streets, or 3 percent, are unpaved. Centerline miles measure the length of a street regardless of width or number of lanes.

Unpaved streets are rare in the higher density parts of Portland, and can be found in mostly-residential areas on local streets.

Since the first City Charter in 1851, the City of Portland has stated that property owners adjacent to unpaved streets have a financial responsibility to improve them to acceptable standards.

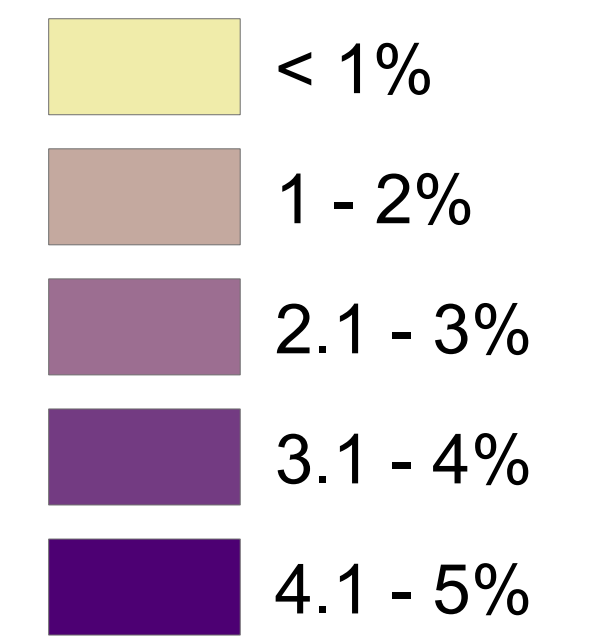
City Code 17.42.010:

"It has been and remains the policy of the City of Portland that streets are constructed at the expense of abutting property owners and are maintained by abutting property owners until street improvements are constructed to the standards of, and accepted for maintenance by, the City. Streets that have not been improved to City standards are not and will not be maintained or improved at City expense, except at the discretion of the City and as provided in this Code and the City Charter."

The City of Portland offers property owners a Local Improvement District (LID) program. LIDs are a mechanism for property owners to share in the cost of transportation infrastructure improvements.

In an effort to reduce the percentage cost of street improvements to property owners, the Portland Bureau of Transportation is developing a new program called Street by Street. The program will lower costs by creating new design alternatives.
