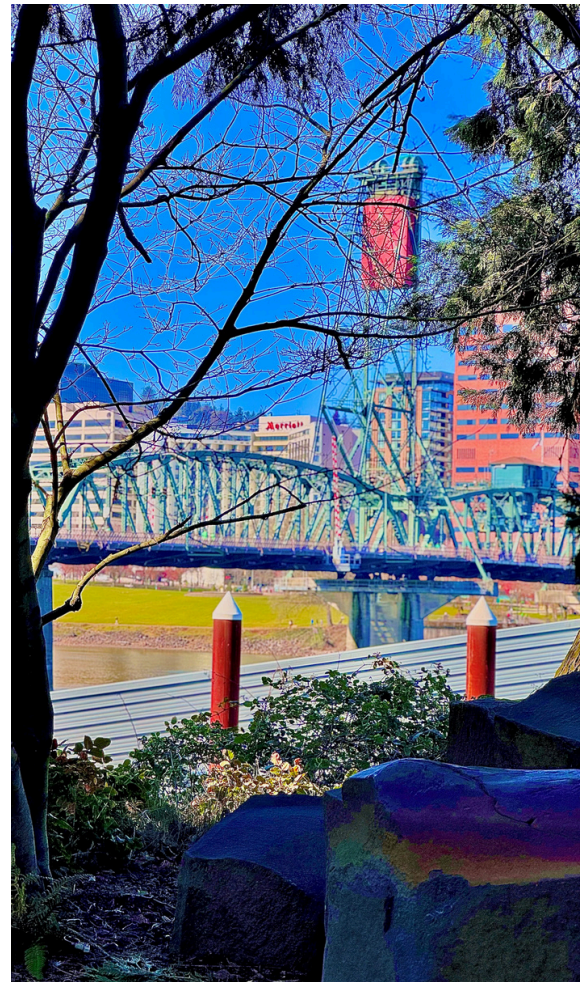
# Job Opportunities
