Following the recent determination of the City of Portland's Small Donor Elections program that the Rene for Portland (ORESTAR ID: 21605) campaign received large in-kind contributions from a corporation (Schnitzer Properties Management LLC) without reporting them, I request that the the City Election Office also determine that a violation of the City's campaign contribution limits has also occurred.
