Following the recent determination of the City of Portland's Small Donor Elections program that the Rene for Portland (ORESTAR ID: 21605) campaign received large in-kind contributions from a corporation (Schnitzer Properties Management LLC) without reporting them, I request that the the City Election Office also determine that a violation of the City's campaign contribution limits has also occurred. Since the in-kind contribution appears to be from a corporation, it would seem to be illegal. Furthermore, I request the City Election Office determine if the Rene for Portland campaign is in violation of disclosure requirements for not listing Schnitzer Properties Management LLC as a dominant contributor on all communications since whatever date they exceeded the threshold. As of today, I see no indication on the campaign website or social media platforms. Please let this serve as an official complaint that a violation has occurred.
