

This week, 2 October – 8 October 2017, we received 636 new campsite reports identifying roughly 110 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 184 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 157 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 2 were of camping on TriMet properties, 3 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway or BNSF right-of-way, and 7 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
