

This week, 24-30 July 2017, we received 577 new campsite reports identifying roughly 110 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 202 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 161 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 0 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway right-of-way, and 15 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
