

This week, 25 September – 1 October 2017, we received 525 new campsite reports identifying roughly 105 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 155 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 129 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 3 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway or BNSF right-of-way, and 12 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
