

This week, 28 August – 3 September 2017, we received 630 new campsite reports identifying roughly 115 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 192 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 155 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 5 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway or BNSF right-of-way, and 12 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
