



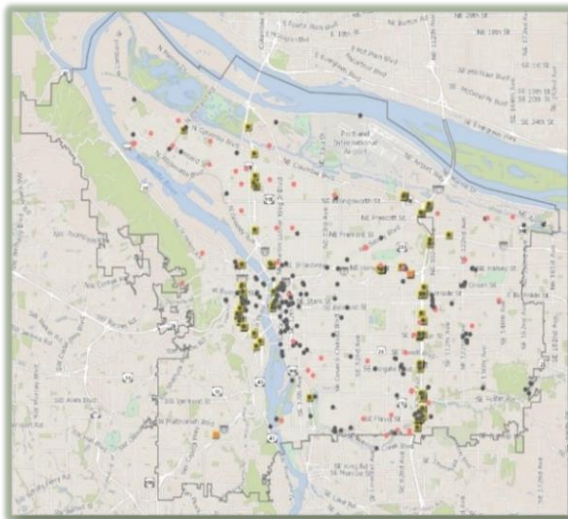

April 30 – May 6, 2018

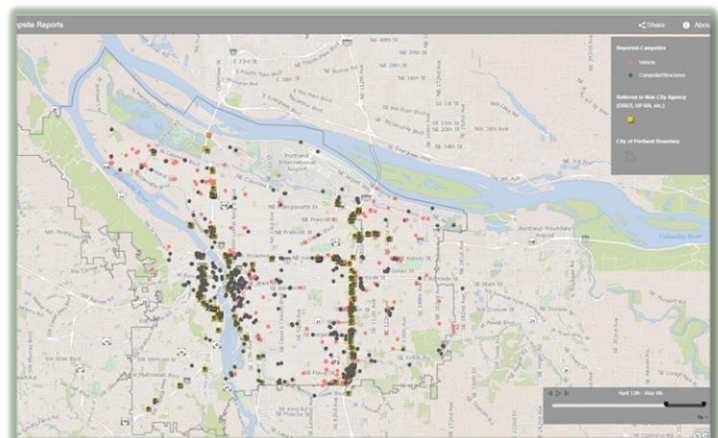
This week we received:

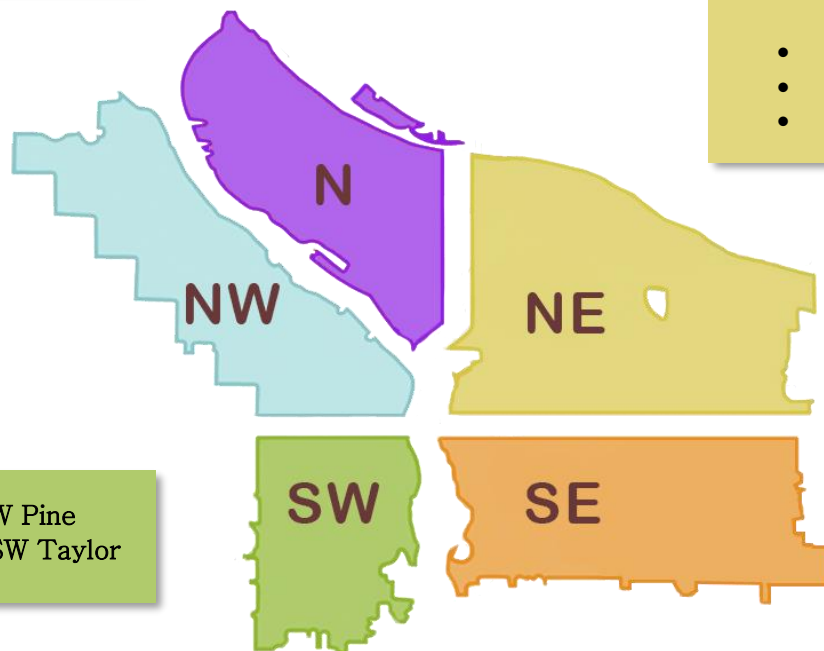
Homelessness/Urban Camping Impact Reduction Update:

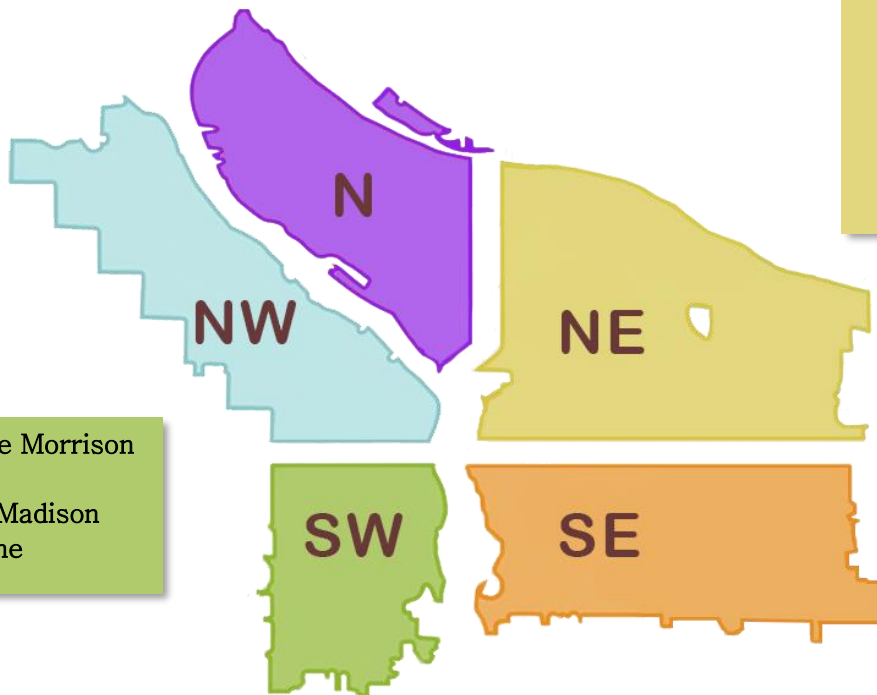

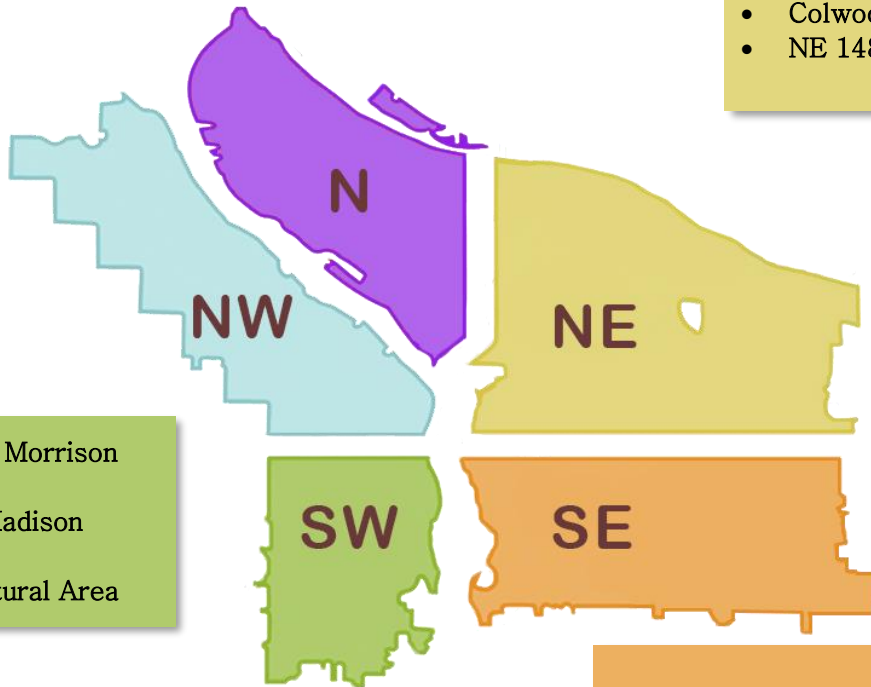
