

This week, 31 July – 6 August 2017, we received 538 new campsite reports identifying roughly 110 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 174 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 190 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 2 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway right-of-way, and 19 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
