### **Self-Medication Agreement**

Participants will be allowed to self-administer medication if they are 13 years of age or older (or under the age of 13 and required to have immediate access to their medication), subject to the following:

1. The participant is developmentally and/or behaviorally able.
2. The parent/guardian has signed the *Self-Medication Agreement* form.
3. The medication must be kept in the original prescription bottle or in clearly marked containers which include the person's name, medication, dosage, and time medication is to be given.
4. Sharing and/or borrowing of medication with another person is strictly prohibited.
5. Permission to self-medicate may be revoked if the participant violates Portland Parks & Recreation policy governing administration of non-injectable medication and/or these regulations.
