ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Team Leader

- Incident safety & objectives
- Assign Roles, delegate authority to others, establish command structure
- Providing information to internal and external parties
- Establishing and maintaining liaison with other responders
- Taking direction from government agencies

Operations Coordinator directs and coordinates incident tactical operations.

Logistics Coordinator assures there are adequate resources to meet incident objectives.

SUV Coordinator processes, orients, and assigns SUVs, under oversight of a NET member.

Pre-Deployment Responsibilities

1. Secure your own home and family
2. Check in with NET team members via cell/text or FRS/GMRS radio.
Channel 9, Backup 14
3. No self-deployment (unless major disaster with communications disabled).

Deployment

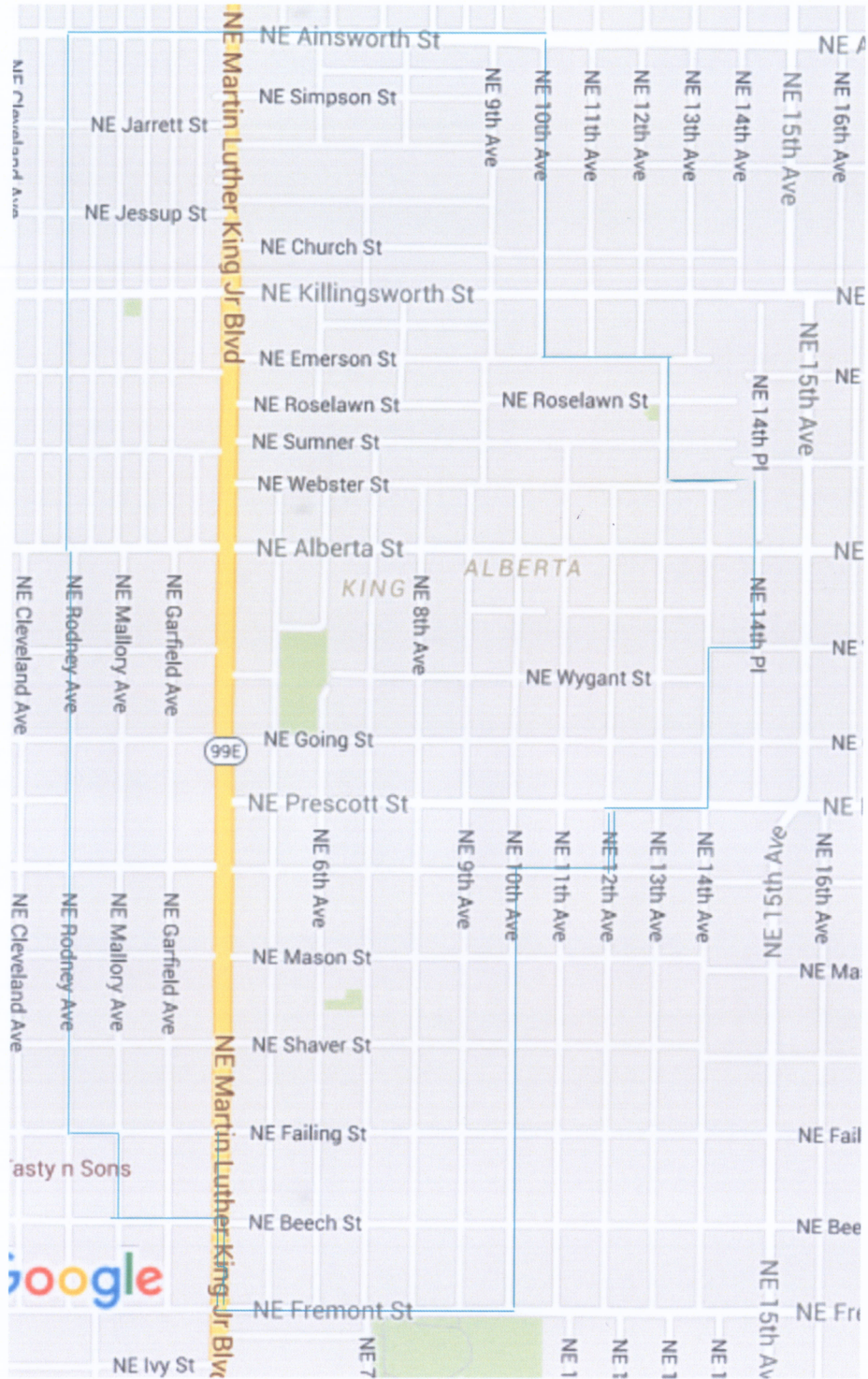
*Once you receive deployment message
... OR in major disaster/self deploy:*

1. Check on neighbors, do triage and turn off utilities, if appropriate.
1. Proceed to Staging Area or, if unsafe, to Backup Staging Area.
2. En route to Staging Area, observe and record damage/injuries using Damage Assessment Form (#1)
3. Ask SUVs to accompany you to Staging Area for Processing.

Amateur Radio Operator priorities:

1. Communicate with Team Leader.
2. Have a means to contact the ECC.
3. Relay messages between ITL & ECC.
