\$295,060,000 divided by \$2,545, the amount per bedroom built with housing bond money approved by voters in Portland (City of Portland 1), is 115,937.131631. Even subtracting the amount earmarked for retirement system payments for fiscal year 2024-2025 from the PPB budget and using the remaining PPB budget for calculations instead, \$279,660,000, that divided by \$2,545 is 109,886.051081. The City of Portland could build 109,886 bedrooms at current costs with the money it is spending on policing this year alone. Even using Central City Concern's figure of 30,000 people affected by homelessness in the City of Portland, this is clearly ample money to end the City of Portland's homelessness crisis with a housing-first approach. This leaves plenty of money to bolster the Portland Street Response's (PSR) budget.

30,000 multiplied by \$2,545 is \$76,350,000, a fraction of the \$279,660,000 Portland is spending on policing this fiscal year alone. \$279,660,000 minus \$76,350,000 leaves \$203,310,000 in the budget to be reallocated. This leaves plenty of money to bring PSR staffing levels up to adequate 24/7 staffing (Myers 10), and Community Health Assess and Treat (CHAT) from four day a week staffing to adequate seven day a week staffing (Myers 14).
