Proposals	<ul> <li>Discussion which proposals will be discussed/voted on during the <u>full board meeting on June 23rd</u>.</li> <li>PCCEP Youth Subcommittee will be presenting a recommendation on Restorative Justice.</li> <li>A <u>Youth-Police Action forum will be held on June 11th at 5pm</u> via Zoom.</li> <li>PCCEP Settlement Agreement and Policy Subcommittee will be presenting three recommendations; (1) Accelerating Truth and Reconciliation Commission, (2) Duty to Intervene and Training, and (3) Foot Pursuit.</li> <li>Currently four Recommendations will be presented on June 23rd.</li> <li>PCCEP staff will short through public recommendations and assigned each recommendation for review to the appropriate subcommittee / or steering committee.</li> <li>PCCEP staff will compile meeting notes from both Sunday special meetings held on May 31st and June 7th to be shared with the full board.</li> </ul>

- O PCCEP members and staff will connect with community organizations to have guest speakers on June 14th.
- Deadline for Thursday June 11th of confirmation from guest speakers to attend the Sunday, June 14th special meeting.
