Welcome	 Check in question – Favorite food or meal during quarantine? A few answers shared – Spaghetti, cobb salad, Indian food, ramen noodles, and french fries.
PPS Youth Survey	 Update from Portland Public Schools (PPS) on the Youth survey: Due to COVID-19 PPS has push back all research submissions and survey research. Plan is for the Youth Subcommittee to reapply in the Fall of 2020.
Outreach Updates	 MacLaren Youth Correctional Facility No updates from McLaren staff. Waiting for approval to have the survey distribute within MacLaren. Change the language of the survey for the MacLaren youth. Youth Subcommittee will follow up with MacLaren staff. Multnomah Youth Commission (MYC) shares their experiences on Youth / Police surveys: The survey will be shared with other members of MYC for feedback. Students of color may be drawn to mark "neutral" on questions regarding police. The option for a paper copy or an online link to the survey was shared with youth. Focus groups were helpful for more personal interaction with youth vs. a survey. Data analysis of the focus groups captured common trends / themes (e.g. lack of interaction with police and hopelessness in change of behavior within police). MYC would like to share the data results with City officials with the support of the Youth Subcommittee.

Craft Recommendation	 MYC crafted recommendations based on their survey results. Reach out to MYC to set up a meeting to have further insight on recommendation developments. The goal is to craft a recommendation based on the survey results from the PCCEP Youth survey.
Next Steps /Strategic Plan	 Strategic Plan next steps: Craft a mission statement and goals for the Youth Subcommittee. Craft the focus areas of the Youth Subcommittee that can be passed on to the next Youth members. Hold a work session to focus on the strategic plan. Review the PCCEP Racial Equity Subcommittee mission statement as an example. Work Session will be held in April to start brainstorming a mission statement, goals and focus areas.
