Supportive Housing combines affordable housing with wrap-around services for people experiencing homelessness. In 2017, Portland City Council resolved to create 2,000 new Supportive Housing units by 2028.

Households supported with COVID-19 rent assistance in Multnomah County

## 1,188

Affordable Inclusionary Housing units permitted

Portland requires large housing developments to include affordable units to create affordability in the private market. 12,000+ total units have been permitted under the Inclusionary Housing program.

Affordable units opened during the Housing State of Emergency

Affordable units in development as of December 2021

The Portland Housing Bureau works toward a vision of Portland where we can all find affordable homes and have equitable access to housing opportunity. We are committed to addressing the housing needs of Portlanders through policies and programs to create new affordable housing, provide rental services for tenants and landlords, promote stable homeownership, and prevent displacement.

## 15,000

PHB-regulated units across the city

PHB provides financing and incentives for the development and preservation of affordable housing. Rents in PHB-supported housing are required to remain affordable at targeted income levels for up to 99 years.

## 1,490

Portland Housing Bond units open or in progress

Voters passed the city's first housing bond in 2016, dedicated \$258.4M to creating at least 1,300 permanently affordable homes.
