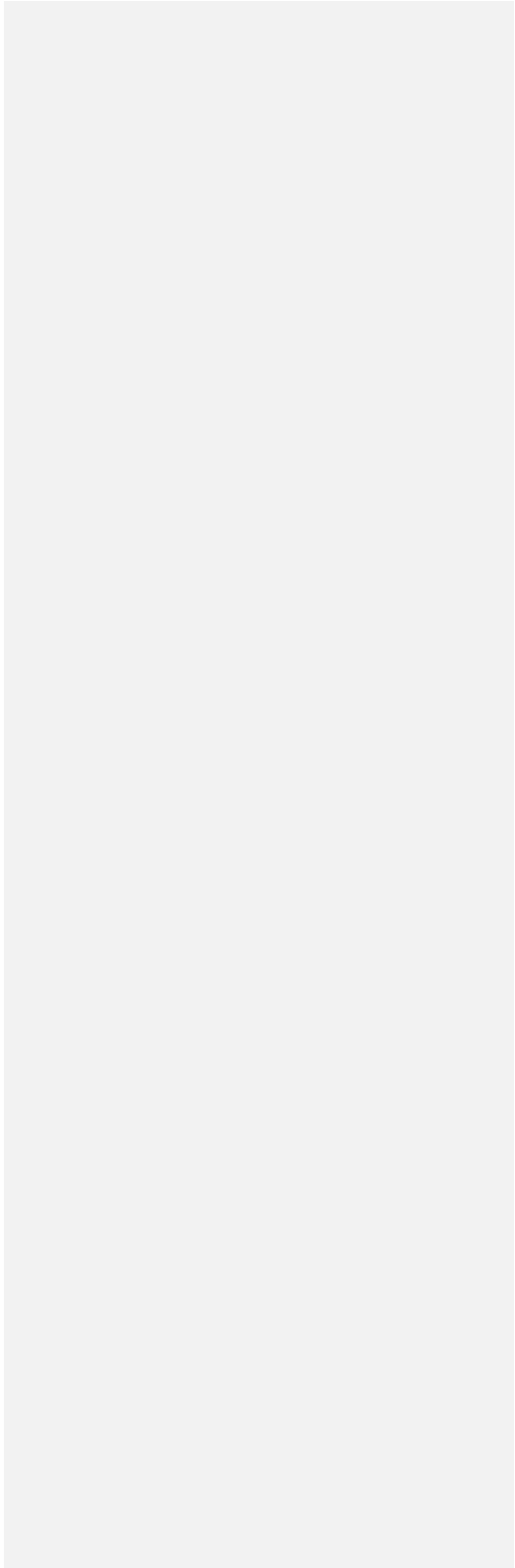

Independent of the police
Driven by the community, led by the community

Independence, community is running the show
Trust, justice, and accountability

Not to be acronymed, acronyms are confusing
Focus on community and the drive is to hold police accountable

Board is there to serve the community and its needs and desires
Not just policing, but pro-community safety

Focus on the community, focus on independence
Something around accountability

Shouldn't come across as bureaucratic, controlling/managing
Community-centered and welcoming to community

Welcoming, not strict or cold
Independence and community are important

Clear, independent judgment
Convey that you can get a fair shake here, community-centered

Careful that the name doesn't sound similar to previous systems, needs testing
Acronyms will be used, so be careful anyway

Community, accountability, independence, and oversight comes to mind too
Use of police and law enforcement in the name is tricky

"The Director is a "Bureau Director" for purposes of Charter section 4-301 and shall be appointed by, and serve at the will and pleasure of, the Board." Charter 2-1005.

"The Board will be a standalone Bureau similar to Prosper Portland. It will not be housed in any other Bureau." PAC Areas of Agreement on Oversight Staff.
