- 1. Meeting called to order at 9:06 AM.
- 2. May 26, 2021 Meeting Minutes
 - a. Neil Lee made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Joe Enlet. Approved unanimously.
- 3. PPB Structure Presentation/Discussion
 - a. Officer Natasha Haunsperger:

First Phase to onboard APIA Advisory Council into the PPB. Council on boarded PPB into our space and very timely. What can we do that is realistic and what can be done later? Budgets does govern their duties. 3 main branches: 1) Chief Lovell at top of all officers in blue, has assistant chief 2) Investigations: Chief Jami Resch (Paka's boss), District Attorney Office, budget controls officers, patrols and 3) Services: Chief Mike Frome. Each division has their own mini-chief.

Natasha is in the office of community engagement (August 2020 and February 2021 had to dismantle due to budget as the budget was reduced. How PPB to adjust with reduced budget on crime prevention, rights of community members, basic functions, etc.

b. Sergeant Paka Searle:

Sergeant Paka oversees domestic violence unit: was 12,000 Officers including Chief, now 800 officers and Portland population increased. There were 5 different precincts with different divisions, now there are 2 divisions: patrol and violence. The breakdown is as follows:

800 total PPB employees, ~500 sworn officers, and FBI recommends 2.7 officers per 1000 residents. PPB currently staffs about 1.2 officers per 1000 residents.

670,000 is the approximate average of our city population

c. Ken Lee, Business Manager:
