SUBJECT
 SB SPOTTED IN CARJACKED VEH

On 04/07/18 at approximately 1925 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] on report of a stolen vehicle (OR/ZRQ832) involved in an earlier car-jacking in East Precinct (Case #18-114703) driving erratically E/B on N. Columbia Blvd, reportedly brandishing a firearm. The caller reported they had video of the suspect and would be waiting at home to report the incident.

While enroute to the call, dispatch updated that (OR/ZRQ832) was indeed the vehicle involved in the car-jacking earlier today in East Precinct and it had reportedly just crashed at SE Martin Luther King Jr Blvd/SE Stark St. Officers shifted their efforts from an area check on my call to the crash location. I continued to the call location to gather video evidence.

Upon arrival, I spoke with RP (Hernandez-Ramirez, Eleazar) who told me he and his wife, WI (Carranza, Maribel), along with their three small children were driving home from the Delta Park Walmart (1123 N. Hayden Meadows Dr) when they observed a silver Honda CRV following them when they got to N. Columbia Blvd. Hernandez said he believed the subject followed him from the parking lot of the Walmart, but he couldn't be sure. Hernandez said the driver began tail-gating him and driving erratically, pulling up next to his car several times in the bike lane, for no apparent reason. Hernandez told me his teenage daughter (whom he did not want listed in the report) began recording the event on Hernandez's cell phone because they were so alarmed by the subject's actions. Hernandez said they clearly saw the above listed plate and described the driver as a bald white male, approximately 35-40 years old, not wearing a T-shirt, with tattoos on his arms and the left side of his chest. Hernandez said he and his family would recognize the man if they saw him again.

I asked Hernandez at what point he and his family saw the gun and he told me they did not actually see a weapon, just the subject reaching for something "black", though they could not tell what it was (there was a slight Spanish language barrier).

I reviewed the video from Hernandez's cell phone, which showed the silver SUV driving erratically all over the road W/B N. Columbia Blvd, passing N. Chautauqua Blvd and approaching N. Portsmouth Ave. The vehicle pulled up to the passenger side of Hernandez's vehicle, despite there not being a travel lane on the right. Hernandez continues W/B on N. Columbia Blvd, and turns S/B on N. Portsmouth Ave, with the subject continuing to follow him. Hernandez's wife and children are visibly and audibly terrified in the video. Hernandez turns W/B on N. Fessenden St from N. Portsmouth Ave, with the suspect vehicle continuing S/B on N. Portsmouth Ave. The suspect appeared to be a white male driver, however due to the rain, the position of the vehicle and where the camera was pointed, I was unable to observe anything further about the suspect beyond that. The video does not appear to show the suspect reaching for any items, by the time they are able to begin recording him, and he does not display a weapon throughout the duration of the video. I notified CE officers of this update, as they were still looking for the suspect who fled the vehicle at the scene of the
