Dear Peninsula Crossing Trail Neighbors,

The **Safe Rest Village** program (SafeRestVillages.org) is moving forward with the development of the Peninsula Crossing Safe Rest Village on nearby City-owned property. Safe Rest Villages are managed outdoor shelters offering those experiencing houselessness basic amenities, on-site 24/7 staffing, and mental and behavioral health support, all with a goal of **helping them transition to their next step off the streets.**

The **Peninsula Crossing Safe Rest Village** will be developed in several phases. We are currently in Phase 2 and will be starting Phase 3 soon. Outreach has finished in the area and camps around the Safe Rest Village location have been removed. The Belmont Goats have been moved to their new location, just south of their original space. The volunteers are thrilled with their new barn and the goats are settling in wonderfully.

Now with the area clean and the goats moved, construction on the Village itself can begin. Temporary fencing is being installed around the perimeter of the village. Trenching and other site work is beginning. Eventually, a 7-foot privacy fence will be installed, and shelter units will be delivered. You will see banners around the site with a site plan of the Village. We have also included the site plan on the reverse of this mailing.
