Before you hop on, **know the rules of the road.**

PBOT is committed to providing meaningful access. For accommodations, modifications, translation, interpretation or other services, please contact 503-823-7566.

State and local laws require that e-scooter riders:

- Are at least 16 years old.
- Wear a helmet.
- Ride on the street—in the bike lane, or vehicle travel lane.
- Do not ride on the sidewalk. Walk scooters on the sidewalk.
- Do not ride in Portland parks, including Waterfront Park, Eastbank Esplanade, or the Springwater Corridor.
- Ride solo, one person per scooter.
- Ride sober. Riding under the influence of intoxicants is prohibited and may result in a DUII.
- Park scooters on the sidewalk, close to the curb, or in designated scooter parking areas. If a scooter is parked in a way that prevents access to the sidewalk, curb ramps, bike lanes, or vehicle travel lanes, you may be fined or your account suspended.
