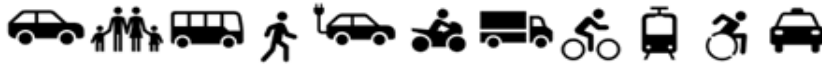

	What we care about:	Description
Sustainability & Health	Climate impact	Contributions to climate change
	Air quality	Pollution in the air
	Health impacts	Human health outcomes resulting from transportation
Moving People & Goods	Efficiency	Movement of people and goods
	Transportation affordability	Household expenditure on transportation
	Availability	What transportation options are available to people, e.g., sidewalks, bus lanes, bike lanes, service frequency
	Reliability	Predictability of travel time
	Connectivity	Ability to get to jobs, services, recreation destinations, and places where you need to go by different modes
	Accessibility	Usability of transportation options by people of all abilities
Safety	Traffic safety	Safety of the system, e.g., crash risk
	Personal safety	Safety perceived by individual users
Economic Opportunity	Transportation-related employment opportunities	Direct and indirect employment throughout construction, operation, and maintenance
	Fair labor practices and living wages	Conditions of those working in transportation
	Inclusive local business and economic activity	Small business health in transportation project locations
Process Equity	Inclusive engagement and outreach	Diversity of perspectives consulted in decision-making processes
