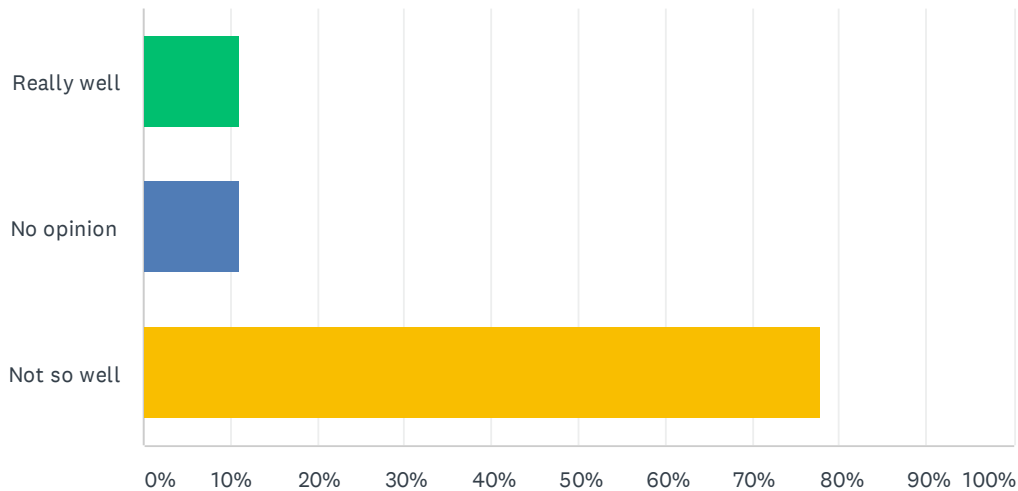


# Q1 How well do you feel the North Campus initial site layout concept screens views of the future filtration facility?

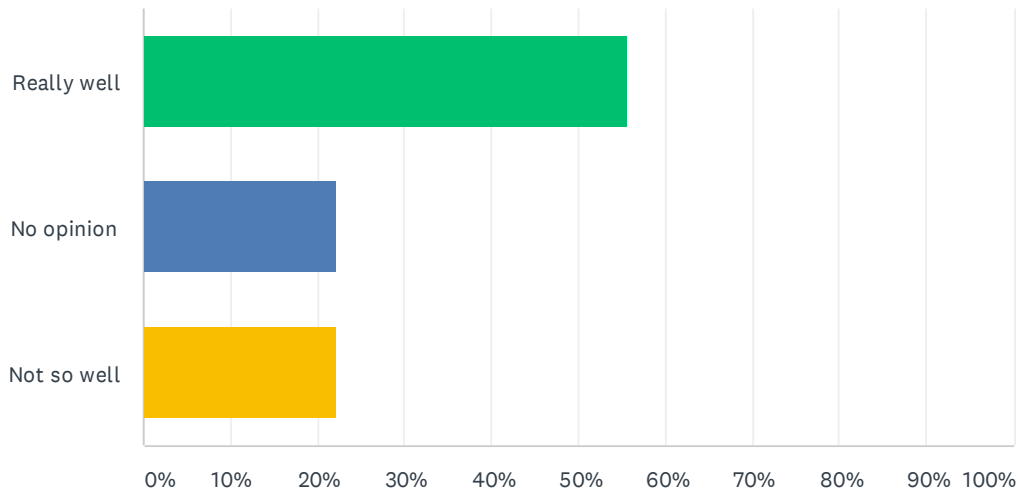

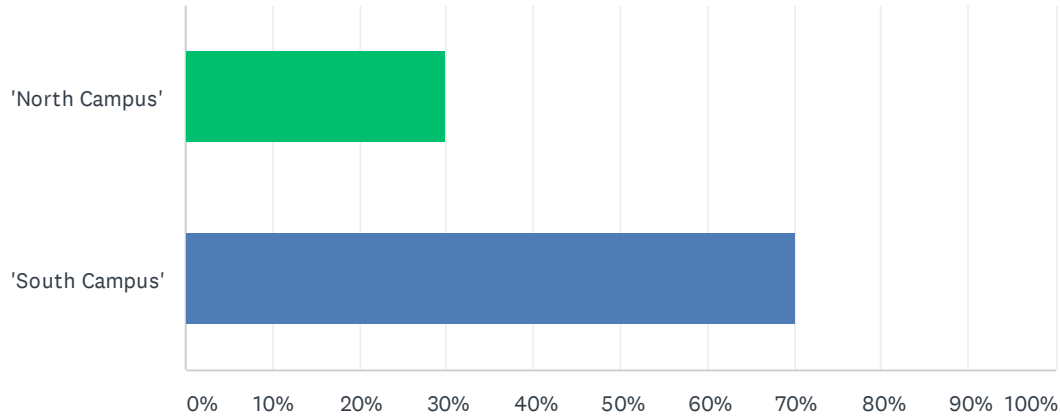
