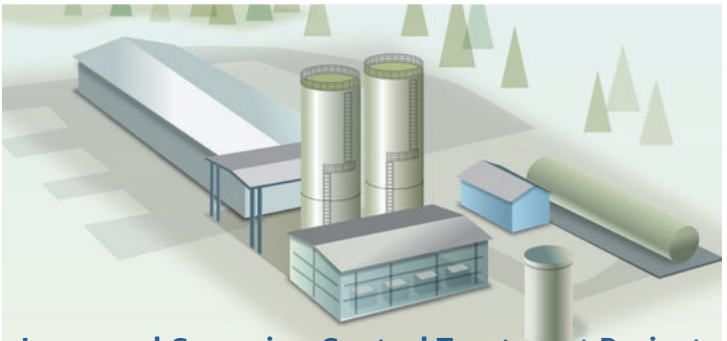

Improved corrosion control treatment is coming to Portland Water Bureau's existing Lusted Hill facility at the corner of Cottrell Road and Lusted Road.



The new facilities are being built at Portland Water Bureau's Lusted Hill facility alongside an existing building.

The project will adjust the chemistry of the water to further reduce levels of lead at the tap using naturally occurring substances to treat the water: soda ash and carbon dioxide.
