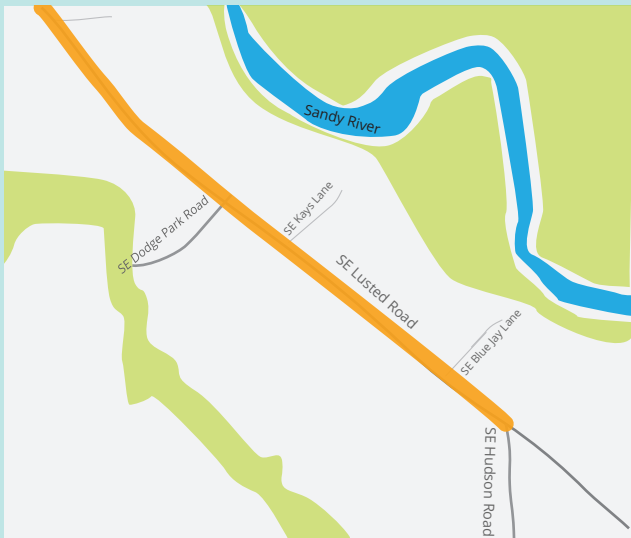

- Flaggers will help direct traffic where work is occurring in the public right-of-way.

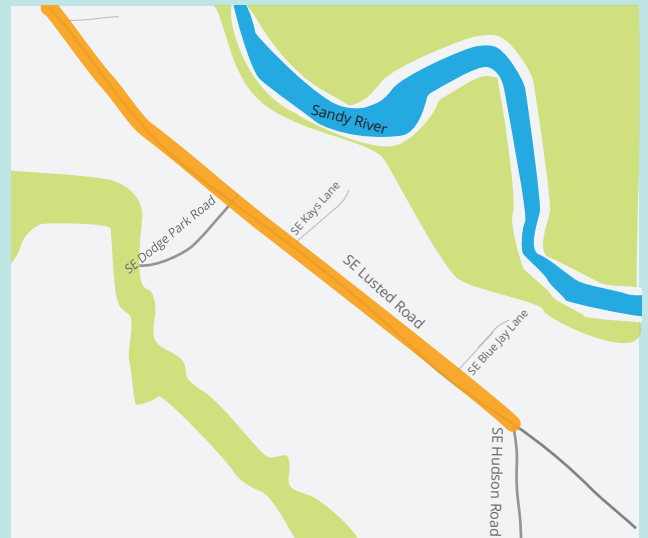
