Even during a pandemic, it's important to clean up Portland's fall leaves. Wet leaves are slick and can be hazardous on our streets and sidewalks. Leaves can also clog storm drains and cause streets and intersections to flood. That's why we're still going ahead with our Leaf Day service this year.

WHAT HAS CHANGED?

Our crews will observe Covid-19 safety protocols while they work for your safety and theirs.

In addition, more people staying home means more cars on the streets. We still need you to move your car for a good clean. So this year, give yourself an extra reminder to move your car ahead of Leaf Day service in your neighborhood.

And of course, Leaf Day is still **FREE!**

MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR LEAF DAY SERVICE

1 CONFIRM YOUR LEAF DAY(S)

Visit us online at portland.gov/leafday to confirm which Leaf Day service district you're in, when your service will be, and to sign up for email or text updates.



2 RAKE EXTRA TREE LEAVES

Our regular Leaf Day service clears your street tree leaves but what about tree leaves on the sidewalk or elsewhere on your property? No problem! We'll take those too. Simply rake them into the street the **day before your Leaf Day(s)**. Remember: **only tree leaves, not any other kind of yard debris.**

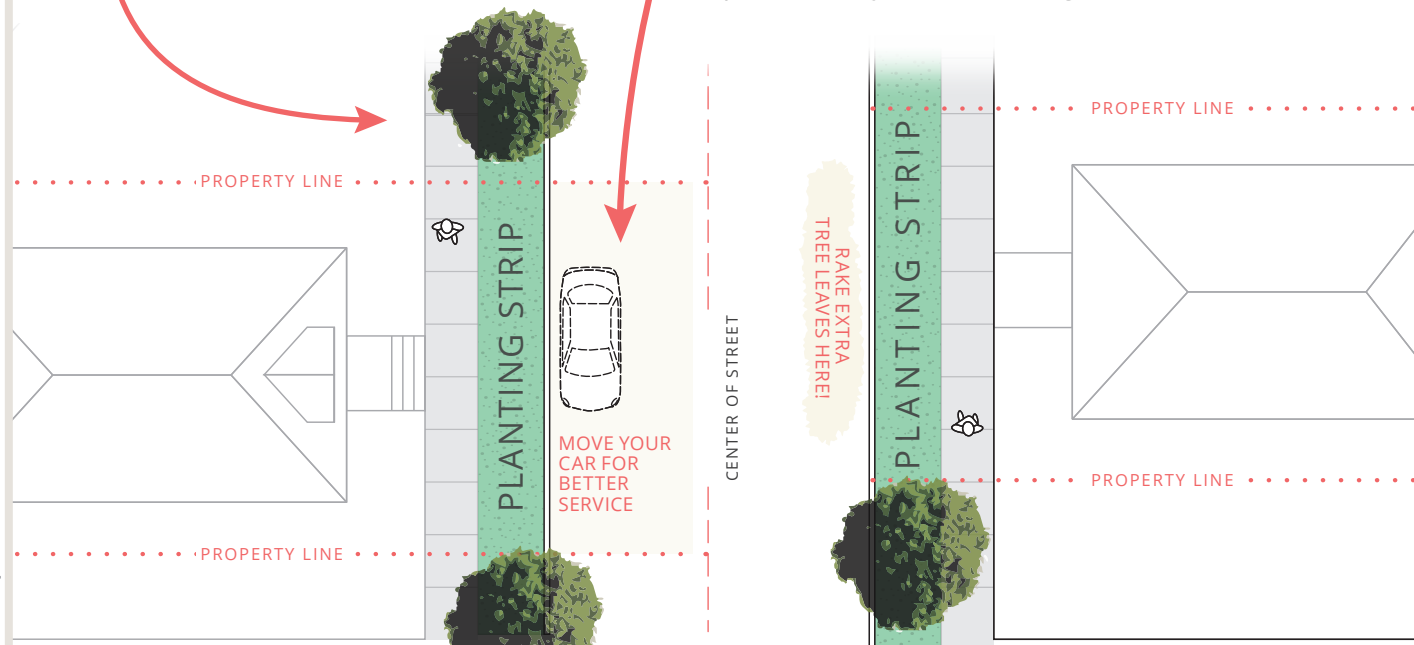


3 HELP US HELP YOU (EVEN MORE IMPORTANT THIS YEAR!)

Here are some other things you can do to help us provide better Leaf Day service.

- Please **remove obstacles** like basketball hoops and garbage bins from the street.
- Please **limb your trees**. Our machines are up to 11-feet high. Low-hanging limbs keep them from hugging the curb and picking up all the leaves.
- More people staying home during the pandemic means more cars on the street. Give yourself an extra reminder to move your car, so our crews can do a good, thorough job.

These things, will make it easier for our machines to operate, and your street will get a better clean!
