

1. **Opening Designated Community Gardens.** Notwithstanding Directive 2 in the September 10, 2020, Emergency Declaration, the community gardens listed in Exhibit A are hereby open effective immediately for activities related solely to use as community gardens during such times as designated by the Portland Bureau of Parks and Recreation; provided, however, the Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management retains the authority to close any listed location if necessitated by an emergency.
2. **Opening Designated Farmers Markets.** Notwithstanding Directive 2 in the September 10, 2020, Emergency Declaration, the farmers markets listed in Exhibit B are hereby open effective immediately for activities related solely to use as farmers markets as provide by active permits; provided, however, the Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management retains the authority to close any listed location if necessitated by an emergency.
3. **Other Provisions.**
 - a. All provisions of the September 10, 2020, Emergency Declaration shall remain in full force and effect, except as specifically modified by this Order No. 1.
 - b. If any provision of the Declaration of Emergency, or any Emergency Orders, directives, commands, or other orders issued under the authority of the Declaration, or their application to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, then the remainder of the duly exercised authority, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of the Declaration of Emergency, or any Emergency Orders, directives, commands, or other orders issued under the authority of the Declaration, are severable.
