4. If you are addressing someone or the group, state their name or say you're addressing the group.

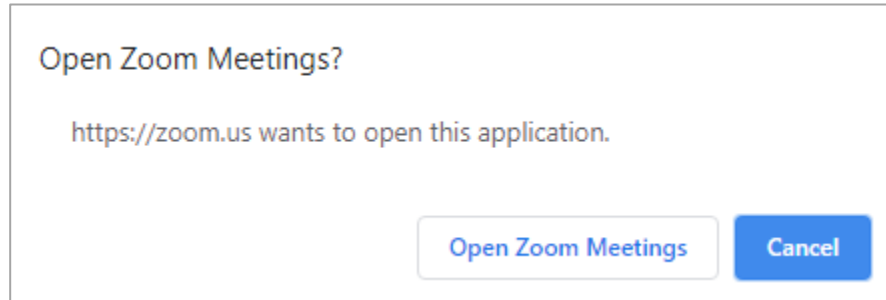

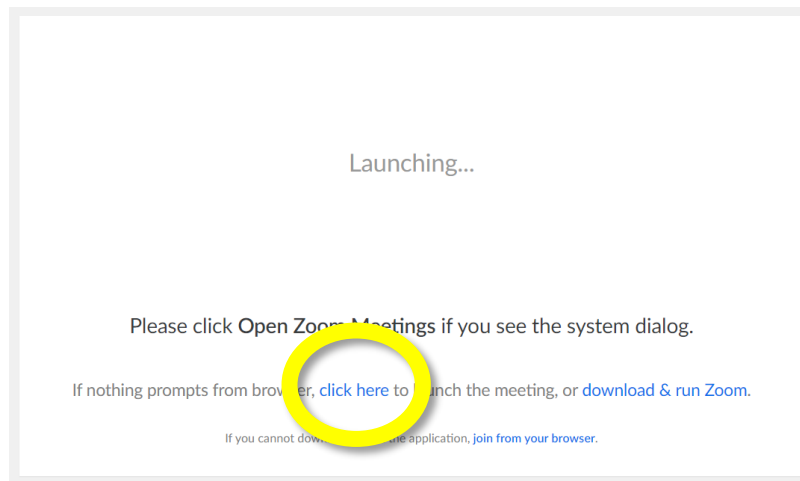
How to Use Zoom

If you are joining virtually via your computer to launch Zoom, follow these steps:

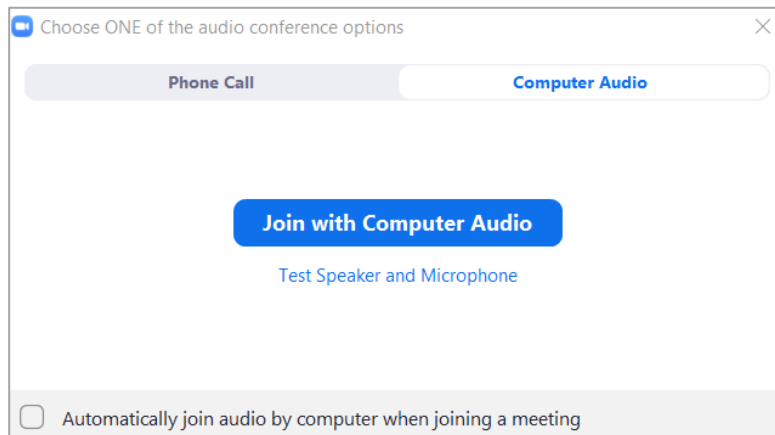
1. Click **Open Zoom Meetings** if the dialogue box appears.

NW Parking SAC Update September 2020

Zone M Permit Updates

Zone M renewals are currently underway. The Area Parking Permit Program team is busy processing permits, however, they are delayed. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Zone M 2019-2020 permits will now be honored through **October 30, 2020**.

The Area Parking Permit Program team has only processed a quarter of the permits they would have typically processed at this time in past years. Once the permits get processed I'll update on the number of permits sold.

Project & Program Updates

Transportation Wallet

NW Meter Expansion

Phase 2 of the NW Meter Expansion is currently underway between NW 24th and NW 25th. Parking Operations engineering techs evaluated the Phase 1 NW Meter Expansion area for any remaining meters that were not installed. There are 4 remaining and will be installed as part of Phase 2.

Pedestrian Lighting Study

The Pedestrian Lighting Study had their first focus group meeting on September 9. The project is underway and will include an inventory of pedestrian lighting at intersections and midblock locations (specifically within the east-west superblocs). The goal of the project is

to adjust the existing overhead cobra lighting to make it better for pedestrians and add in pedestrian lighting poles when needed. The project should wrap up before June to begin implementation.

Healthy Businesses

A grant is almost near completion and is currently under review by the Bureau's attorney. I've heard that the outdoor seating will likely continue, so this grant could help businesses winterize their outdoor seating.

NW Off-Street Consultant Project

The scope for the NW Off-Street Parking Demand and Feasibility Study is in review and preparation by procurement. Hopefully the RFP will be live within the next month.

NW Flanders Floating Bus Stop Platforms

As part of the Rose Lane Project, two floating bus stop platforms were installed on NW Flanders. The post from Next Door where the person crashed their bike on the platform must have happened in the short period of time when they were only partially completed (judging by Planning's review of the photo). Now that they're done, they have plenty of reflective wands and green paint so it's obvious where to go. They should not be hazardous, but please let us know if you have any further concerns.
