Increased garbage service for low-income households with health condition related waste

The City of Portland offers additional garbage service at no cost for households with increased garbage needs due to adult diapers or other health condition-related waste.

Increased garbage service means increasing your current garbage cart to one size larger (carts are available in 20, 35, 65, or 90-gallons) or adding an additional 35-gallon garbage cart.

Health condition related waste includes adult diapers and other incontinence supplies. (This does not include diapers used by children under the age of four, feminine hygiene products, or any waste that falls under the definition of "Infectious Waste.")
