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INFORMATIONAL: DEVHUB VS. PROJECTDOX OVERVIEW

What's the difference between DevHub and ProjectDox?

DevHub is often used in tandem with ProjectDox; they are different tools used for different purposes.

Permit Requests are initiated and an initial prescreen done through DevHub; it is also where you pay for your permit fees. Permit requests submitted through DevHub follow one of two paths: Single PDF Process or Full ProjectDox, depending on the number of plan pages and the complexity of the project and the permit being requested.

Think of ProjectDox as a virtual version of the paper plan rolls. It allows the City to do comprehensive plan reviews.

Are the DevHub & ProjectDox passwords the same?

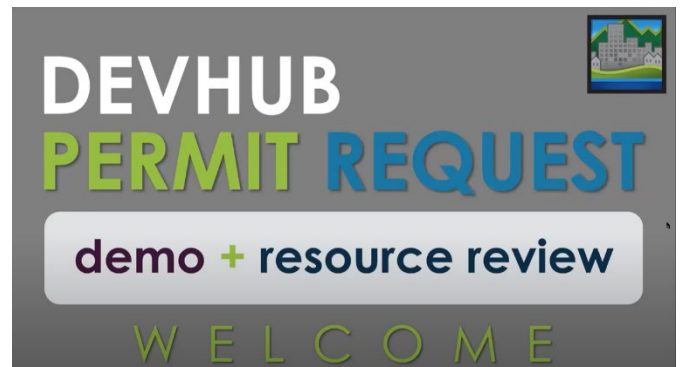
Because DevHub and ProjectDox are different tools, they require different user accounts and login information. For some projects, applicants will need to manage a DevHub account and a ProjectDox account.
