The safety of our employees and the people we serve is Portland Parks & Recreation's (PP&R) highest priority.

To protect employees from the spread of COVID-19, PP&R has put in place strict safety protocols informed by public health guidance from the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). All PP&R employees must follow all COVID-19 safety protocols. All PP&R program participants are also required to follow COVID-19 safety protocols.

We want you to join our team to help serve our community, and we want you and your family to understand how PP&R will protect employees from COVID-19. Please review the following information to understand the steps put in place to protect employees' health. Staff that exhibit COVID-19 symptoms or who are possibly exposed are never expected to come to work.

MANDATORY STAFF PRACTICES FOR COVID-19 SAFETY



Wearing a face covering is always required indoors, and outdoors around others.



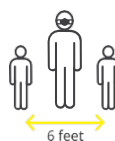
Frequent hand sanitation, upon arrival to a PP&R facility and throughout the day.



Daily health assessment is required prior to arrival at a PP&R facility.



Frequent cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces and equipment.



Six feet of physical distance at all times between coworkers and community members.



Daily sign-in at every facility for contact tracing purposes.

Strict maximum occupancy limits in indoor spaces.
