

# NW Johnson Neighborhood Greenway Enhancement Project

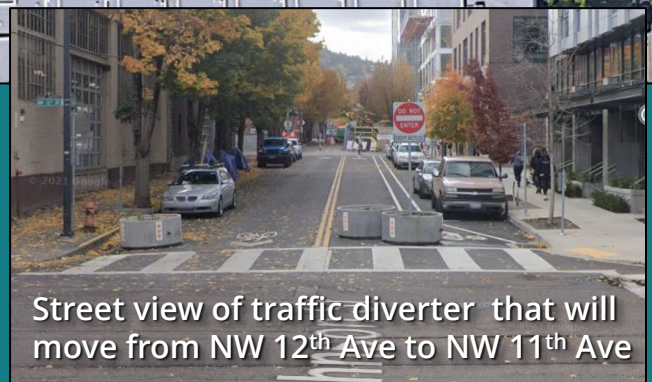
## ADJUSTMENT TO TRAFFIC PATTERN COMING IN 2022



**What is happening:** PBOT is relocating the NW Johnson Neighborhood Greenway traffic diverter from NW 12<sup>th</sup> Ave to NW 11<sup>th</sup> Ave.

**Why the change:** The current placement of diverters at NW 12<sup>th</sup> Ave and NW 14<sup>th</sup> Ave has led to NW 13<sup>th</sup> Ave being the only route into the area, which has become an issue for small businesses during temporary traffic closures on NW 13<sup>th</sup> Ave.

**Additional background:** PBOT typically builds neighborhood greenways by getting improvements on the ground quickly using non-permanent materials, observing how the projects perform, and making changes as needed before investing in higher-cost, permanent materials. We listened to public feedback on the recent projects and are responding to needs that have been identified.
