Significant Changes in Current Draft

Amendment	Change
#5 Grant City Forester authority to approve removal of dead Heritage trees without UFC Consent	Removed. To be considered in future amendment project.
#6 Add Administrative review step to appeal process	Changed timeline to appeal from 10 days to 14 days
#10 Consider tree removal impacts to other trees	Does not apply to Type A permits
#36 Definition of a dangerous to include threats to the urban forest	Removed. To be considered in future amendment project.
#42 Amend permit requirements for pruning in Environmental Overlay Zones and Wildfire Hazard Zones	Removed. To be considered in future amendment project.
