How is this impacting your industry?	Upfront Fares will hurt the drivers of Portland Here's an example we can use as ammo to try and block up-front pricing, or to make sure we see higher minimums on per mile and per min.
Reason for consideration or change to the regulations?	The example shows no long pickup fee either. That ride in Portland would work out like this today: •Long pickup (I think it is anything longer than nine min, and 10 miles) \$4.32 For time I took nine min off the pickup distance of 23 min to get 18 min x \$0.2399 \$7.68 for distance I took 10 miles off the pickup distance of 20.9 miles to get 10.9 x \$0.7049 Ride at PDX UberX rates Distance = \$9.43 (13.38 miles x \$0.7049) Time = \$5.04 (21 min x #.2399) Total for this trip in Portland = \$26.47
