

1. IPR=Independent Police Review Division,

professional staff in Auditor's office. Could do investigation instead of sending to IA. (Looked at first community complaint in 2014)

2. Possible findings are: Sustained (out of policy) Exonerated (in policy) Not Sustained (insufficient evidence) Unfounded (did not happen as alleged).

3. Police Review Board:

Assistant Chief, Supervisor, 1-2 Peer officers. 1-2 civilians, IPR Director (7 members for Force, 5 for Discipline review)

4. CRC=Citizen Review Committee:

in IPR office. 11 volunteer members hear appeals and decide if finding supported by the evidence. If no appeal, complaint ends Civilian can appeal non-sustained findings, officers can appeal sustained ones.

- 5. Council has only ever heard two appeals, in 2003 and 2017. In theory, their decision on what the finding should be is final.
- 6. If the final finding is "Sustained." the Chief imposes discipline.
