Portland Police Bureau Required Documents Checklist

You will be required to present each of the following documents to a Background Investigator at the time of your Oral Board Interview. You should bring a copy of each document as well as the original with you. We will verify each document, keep the copies, and return the original to you. Some items may require substantial time to obtain. It is therefore recommended that you begin requesting official copies as soon as possible. If an item does not apply to you, write "N/A" on the line. Otherwise, initial each line to affirm that you have obtained the document.
