Catherine Sherraden and Libby Winter from TriMet will present to the committee refinements to this affordable housing project being planned for the Hollywood Transit Center. Of especial interest to the committee will be discussion about the stair/ramp design, access to the future Sullivan's Gulch Trail, and cyclist mobility and access to and near the site. The proposal was recently considered at a July 7 th hearing before Portland's Design Commission . The BAC previously submitted feedback on this project in a July 2021 letter .
