SW Broadway Bike Improvements update

Reza: Will busy cross streets like Taylor, Oak be phase separated?

Briana: Yes, as part of later phase

Reza: noticed no left turn bike box at Broadway and Salmon, suggest anywhere we have planned bikeways, facilitate two-stage left

Briana: Makes sense – will make that request.

Reza: how can we make sure we minimize conflicts with 3-min drop off?

Briana: we chatted a little about this with our engineers about additional signage on the pavement or vertical signage – we are open to suggestions.

Emily: I am really worried about the mixing zone btw Yamhill and Taylor. Outreach to other walking and biking organizations would be a great place to start

Briana: Can't do phase separation with the current signal equipment and the turning the volume

Milly: Is there anything we can do with temporary materials? Or reroute traffic off SW Broadway to lessen the conflict?

Briana: We can ask our engineers about that.

Madi: Is there anything at Madison to help cyclists to get to the Hawthorne Bridge?

Briana: We can definitely look at that.

Liz: Will there be issues or confusion at the transition at SW Clay?

Briana: The idea is to connect to the parking protected bike lane in the PSU campus, which starts south of Clay.



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Josh: This is actually my bike route, very excited. Love the NB connection from Harvey Milk. I just wanted to ask if you have incorporated any lessons learned from the NW Broadway project? It can be really challenging as a cyclist if something is blocking the bikeway. The enforcement is really important to ensure these bike lanes stay clear

Briana: Great point, we'll check in with our maintenance team.

Closing roundtable

Milly: Willing to talk with engineers to convince them on mixing zone

Peter: Very important to integrate planning into the design process.

Madi: It's a shame when a facility is an all ages and ability route except for one block, maybe a temporary facility on 6th until the signal gets fixed?

Briana: We hadn't discussed that before, can look at it.
