Re: New crossing island and corner ramp at SE 64th and Division

Dear Southeast Portland Neighbor,

I am writing to notify you of an upcoming change to the intersection of SE Division Street and SE 64th Avenue. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) plans to construct two new curb ramps on the southeast corner and replace the temporary crossing markers with a permanent concrete island. A new streetlight luminaire will also be added on the north side of Division Street.

These improvements will bring the eastern crossing up to current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards and install a permanent crossing island that requires less maintenance. The Fixing Our Streets 10-cent gas tax program provides funding to replace temporary materials with permanent infrastructure.

Construction is planned for spring or summer of 2026. Project schedules can change depending on weather and staff availability.
