

Overview

The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is currently running a four-month pilot for shared electric scooters (e-scooters), and we want to hear from you!

Your responses will help PBOT staff determine whether e-scooters contribute to the City's mobility, equity, safety, and climate action goals.


