Kenton Neighborhood Greenway Network Expansion

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

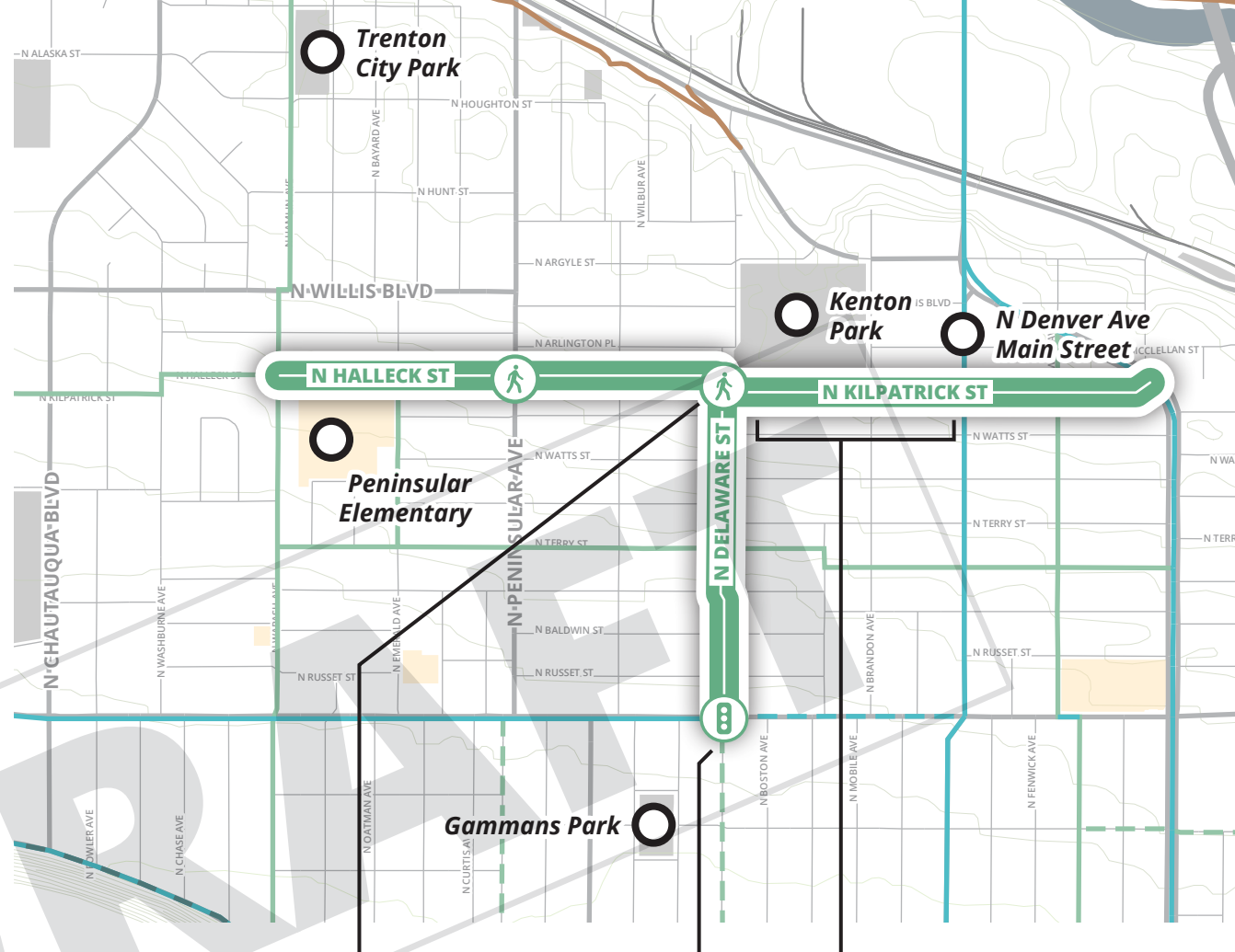
A bundle of new Neighborhood Greenways intended to expand and improve the network in the Kenton Neighborhood. This project would likely be delivered in multiple phases addressing individual segments.

The **Delaware Neighborhood Greenway** is an extension of a funded project stretching from Willamette Blvd to Lombard.

The **Halleck/Kilpatrick Neighborhood Greenway** extension provides east-west connectivity through the Kenton main street.

Project elements may include:

- Wayfinding and signage
- Speed bumps as required
- Strategies to minimize bike/bus conflict with TriMet Line 4, including potential route and station adjustments to the bus.
- Traffic diversion may be required to reduce traffic volumes in some sections.



Consider redesigning the irregular intersection at the southwest corner of Kenton Park

Partner with ODOT to improve the existing crossing of N Delaware Ave and N Lombard St

Remove center-line and add traffic calming on N Kilpatrick St to reduce vehicle speeds
