PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project closes a critical gap in the network by providing a safer connection for people biking over I-5 on N Alberta St. This busy section of N Alberta St is where many people traveling access I-5 and is an awkward, difficult connection for people walking and biking today due to the confusing multi-lane 4-way stop near the on/off ramps. This project is especially important because of the limited bike-friendly east-west routes between the North Portland peninsula and nearby North/Northeast Portland destinations.

This project redesign the layout of N Alberta St to provide a separated, comfortable bike lane connection between N Interstate Ave and the N Michigan Ave Neighborhood Greenway. Futhermore, this project would add bike boxes and no-turn-on-red at the signalized intersection at N Interstate Ave to reduce conlifcts and improve pedestrian and bike safety.

PBOT has already secured approval from ODOT to restripe the lanes on the bridge structure, though the poor pavement condition necessitates repaving before existing lines can be removed and replaced.
